Grant Writing Techniques 101

Techniques for Grant Writing: Planning

Funding Eligibility Checklist

Make sure that you carefully read the entire grant application

- ✓ Write down the questions that you have as you review the eligibility.
- \checkmark Check the eligibility criteria and identify any questions.
- \checkmark Know what deadlines you need to meet.
- \checkmark Understand how to submit the grant.
- Review all templates such as work plans, budgets and evaluations in advance.

Techniques for Grant Writing: Planning Cont...

Getting To Know the RFP

Take the time to review the questions.

- ✓ Do you understand the questions?
- ✓ What questions does it generate for you?
- ✓ Attend any funding announcement meetings or webinars.
- ✓ Review the grant website for FAQs and other information.

✓ Do you need letters of recommendation?

Techniques for Grant Writing: Planning Cont...

Is This Grant Right For Your Organization?

Take Inventory of Your Organization

- ✓ Will the funding amount make an impact for your organization? Is it seed funding or a longer-term investment in what you are looking to obtain?
- ✓ Would this funding support or bolster your organization's staffing and infrastructure at this time?
- ✓ Will it help address the needs of the population/group(s) that you work with and serve?
- ✓ Does it align with your organization's mission and core work?
- ✓ Would a partner help you accomplish your goals?
- ✓ How can you engage your stakeholders and clients?

Techniques for Grant Writing: Writing your Grant

Things To Remember

- ✓ Define your <u>goals</u> and <u>objectives</u> clearly.
- \checkmark Did you demonstrate the <u>needs</u> of the population you serve?
- ✓ Identify your measures, metrics, outcomes, etc. Who will do your <u>evaluation</u>?
- ✓ Have you demonstrated what the impact of your work will be?
- ✓ <u>Resources</u> & <u>capacities</u> what/who do you have to do this work?
- ✓ Ensure that the <u>budget</u> aligns with what you've outlined in your grant application.

Techniques for Grant Writing: Writing your Grant Cont...

Other Key Points

- Be concise.
- Answer all the questions.
- Highlight work you've done in the past if this grant aligns with a subject matter that you are an expert in.
- If this is a new subject matter for your organization, be clear on how you plan to develop expertise through your planning process and the impact you hope to have.

Techniques for Grant Writing: Reviewing before submitting

Review Your Work

You've answered the questions. What's next?

- ✓ Review, review, review.
- ✓ Have someone else review it with "fresh eyes," including internal and external colleagues.
- ✓ Ensure that you followed the word count, font size and other required formats.
- ✓ Conduct a final checklist review on templates, attachments, etc.
